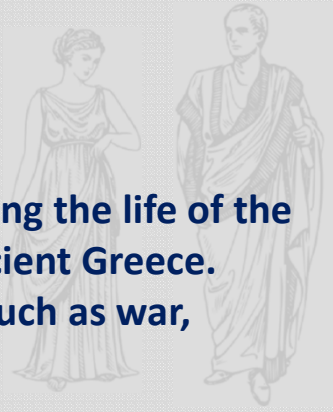


Year 3



Great Greeks is our Year 3 Spring topic. We will be exploring the life of the Greeks to learn what it would have been like to live in Ancient Greece. The pupils will also find out about various aspects of life such as war, architecture, belief and sport.

As people at this time were developing as a society the children will experience how art was used to record life. The class will have the chance to create their own comedy and tragedy masks. We will also be designing and making our own Greek sculptures. In Year 3 we will be making our own model Labyrinth. The children will also be using a variety of materials to create a model of the Parthenon. Of course the theme of Great Greeks does not involve only the past. Throughout this topic we will also be exploring Greece by comparing Ancient Greece with what it is like today. We will be reading a selection of fiction and non-fiction books, including myths and legends, that link to our theme.

The children will become scientists exploring the kind of food a Greek would have eaten to prepare himself to be an athlete. We will also consider the great thinkers of the time who laid the foundations for modern Science and Maths.

Year 3 will also be learning outside the classroom. Visiting the Life Centre will give us the opportunity for an exciting hands-on exploration of Ancient Greek Science. Year 3 will also become archaeologists to discover more about the Ancient fighting forces and Greek art. During Spring term Year 3 will be going on a voyage of Greek discovery.
