Departure Day

What You Need

- 3 T-shirts

The Visit

Upon Arrival:

You will be dropped off and your luggage will be put onto a mini bus.

We will then walk two and a half miles to the centre.

You NEED to wear: comfortable shoes, trousers (not jeans) a t-shirt, jumper/fleece and a coat.

We will have a packed lunch – provided by the centre.

The 'important stuff'

- Unfortunately there is no mobile signal in the house, but we have constant access to the landline and will contact you immediately if there is a problem.
- St. James' staff will be with the children throughout the residential.
- We will update you regularly with our Teachers2Parents Text Service.

Supervision and Safety

- 3 members of staff to accompany children.
- Highly trained and qualified staff lead and supervise the children throughout all activities; St James' staff will also be present.
- Outside of activities, Robinwood and St James' staff are timetabled to supervise at all times, including meals.
- Evening and Night supervision is rigorous with staff on duty in corridors at all times and a member of St James' on call at all times.

- Children sleep in dormitories with bunk beds and rooms that sleep from 2 to 14 children.
- The dormitories will only be for our school, as will all activity groups and meals.
- The showers (separate boys and girls) are timetabled after each wet and muddy activity and have separate cubicles to ensure privacy.

Bedrooms

You will find out when the instructors tell you at the centre but you are guaranteed to be with at least one person you have nominated

Groups

For the activities you will be split into three groups –

River, Lake and Rapids (TBC)

All activities will be completed in these groups

Medication

- If you need any prescribed medication, you need to complete a form and hand it into Mrs Gillis before Wednesday 26th June.
- Medication to be clearly labelled and handed to staff before or on morning of travel.
- To avoid taking 30 bottles of Calpol; if your child normally has this if they have a headache, etc. please sign the form so that we can administer it. If the form is not signed we can not administer the medication.
