Creative Arts Club

Creative Arts Club will continue again this term for pupils in KS2. The club is a chance for your child to experience the creative arts in a safe, happy and structured setting. We will incorporate singing, dancing and acting into our sessions which will culminate in a performance which will be presented to our peers during assembly once a term.

The club will take place on a **Wednesday** evening from 3:30pm to 4:30pm. The first session will begin on **Wednesday 15th January** and then every **Wednesday** after that until **Wednesday 2nd April**. The club will be taken by members of staff from the school. The children can bring a healthy snack and a water bottle.

There is a small charge of £2.50 per session to cover the costs. Children who signed up in October are members for the whole academic year, however we will ask for payments on a termly basis. For this term up until Easter we are asking for £27.50 to be paid in full before the club commences on **Wednesday 15th January**. This can be paid via ParentPay.

If your child no longer wants a space at Chess Club you MUST let us know as soon as possible so that we can offer the space to children on the waiting list. If your child would still like to take part but you are worried about payment, don't let this deter you, just please get in touch with the school office, where we will be happy to discuss.
